1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Rajan Kumar, 2. Navin Jha and 3. Narendra**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with **Cyber P.S Case No. 33/2026** registered u/s 316(2), 318(4), 319(2), 336(3), 340(2), 351(4), 61(2) of BNS and 66, 66(C), 66(D) of Information Technology Act.

2. The prosecution story in brief as per informant Sub Inspector Ravish Rnajan is that on 13.04.2026, he got a secret information that in a rented accommodation at Saharsa, a call center is indulged into cyber fraud. On such information the police raided the rented house and apprehended 3 girls namely Vina Kumari, Lushi Kumari and Madhu Rai, who on interrogation stated that **a fake marriage center** is being run at this place, which is cheating general public in the name of marriage and taking money. It has been further stated in the FIR that there is a facebook I.d. of this fake marriage center in the name of Sathi Samuhik Vivah Yojna and the main master mind who is running this fake marriage center is Rajan Kumar and his associate Navin Jha and Narendra.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the State.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence and they have falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submits that the petitioner are unemployed youth and and there is no any criminal antecedent against the petitioners.

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5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail stating that the petitioners are indulged into cheating several unmarried person across the country and taking money from them and involved in Cyber fraud.

6. Considering the nature of crime being Cyber fraud and cheating **AND** the fact that investigation is still going on, this court **is not inclined** to grant anticipatory bail to the accused/petitioners namely Rajan Kumar, Navin Kumar and Narendra, hence their prayer is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
