1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Surendra Yadav @ Vidyarthi**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Bihra P.S Case No. 41/2026** registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 110, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of BNS.

2. The prosecution story in brief as per informant Bharat Karori is that on 05.02.2026 at about 10:00 AM, the accused/petitioner Surendra Yadav @ Vidyarthi, who had purchased honey and due to getting this honey frozen, started abusing and attacked and beaten his son-in-law and when the informant intervened then he was also beaten by accused/petitioner. It has further been alleged that co-accused Kaju Yadav attacked upon the informant and inflicted head injury resulting into broken head and bleeding.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the State.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case.

5. Ld. APP strongly and vehemently opposes the bail of the accused/petitioner stating that the injury of informant is serious in nature including **hematoma formation** in right posterior region. He further submits that injury of informant upon his head including lacerated wound over occipital region. He further submits that petitioner has 19 criminal antecedent.

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6. Perused the record and case diary. On perusal of record, it transpires that petitioner Surendra Yadav @ Vidyarthi has 19 criminal antecedent, which are as follows:-

Considering the injury upon **vital part of the body** of the informant **AND** 19 criminal antecedent, this court **is not inclined** to grant anticipatory bail to the accused/petitioner namely **Surendra Yadav @ Vidyarthi**, hence his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
