	06.06.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Chandan Mandal @ Chandan Kumar S/o Ashok Mandal who is in custody since 11.02.2026 in connection with Sonbarsa Raj P.S. Case No. 29/2026 registered under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State assisted by learned counsel for the informant. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 11.02.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that Section 109(1) of BNS is added to make the case graver and non-bailable. It is further submitted that petitioner has no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further	

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<u>Cont/2-</u> <u>06.06.2026</u>	submitted that petitioner is the sole earning member of his family and is a man of means and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. assisted by learned counsel for the informant has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case, in short as per the written application of informant Mithu Ram is that on 14.02.2026 at about 03:00 O'clock his co-villager Chandan Mandal, Maya Devi, Ramkaran Mandal armed with lathi, danda, sword, dabiya and countrymade pistol came at his door and assaulted with filthy words and accused no. 1 has tried to assault on his head by sword but he anyhow saved himself. Then the accused no. 2 assaulted on his head by sword but he again tried to save himself but he sustained severe injury and cutting of his thumb. On raising alarm when his neighbour Kalawati Devi came to rescue him then she was knocked down by the accused on PCC road due to which sustained injury on her head and blood started oozing. When the nearby villagers came there then the accused persons fled away from there. The accused persons was searching of his wife saying that they would rape her and kill her by cutting her with the sword. The accused persons are anti-social notorious persons of the society. With the help of his wife and bhabhi he brought to PHC, Sonbarsa where he was referred to	
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Sadar Hospital, Saharsa for treatment.

7. As per the case of prosecution the injured has sustained two injuries i.e. (I) Left thumb auto amputation and (ii) lacerated wound on left arm size approx 3 cm x ½ inch x ½ inch. As per the Doctor the cause of injury is blunt object. The nature of injury is grievous. Though the injury is on non-vital part of the body however the accused person by their act made the injured handicapped, as thumb plays very vital role in many day to day activities. The injured now has to remain without his left thumb his whole life. There are allegations that the accused persons have tried to inflict blow on the head of the injured however he escaped the blow by bowing down his head.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the trauma with which the injured is suffering, the judicial conscience of this court is not permitting it to grant bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner Chandan Mandal @ Chandan Kumar is hereby **rejected**.
