	19.05.2026	This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Shivam Kumar @ Shivam Kumar Trivedi S/o Mithlesh Kumar Trivedi who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. Case No. 273/2026 registered under Sections 103(1), 61(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and Section 27 of the Arms Act. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge, malice and enmity. It is further submitted that the petitioner bears criminal antecedent of one case in which he is on bail. It is further submitted that the petitioner was out of station at the time of occurrence. It is further submitted that the allegations leveled against the petitioner is false and concocted. It is further submitted that petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence in this case and he is also ready to obey the terms and conditions imposed by the learned court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory	

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bail to the petitioner.

4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused.

6. The prosecution case, in brief, is that as per the typed report of informant Jageshwar Jha is that on 13.03.2026 at about 09:00-09:30 P.M. his son Satish Jha @ Chhotu went to salon in front of Meera Talkies saying that he would get his hair and beard. He had to go to a function. Due to repeated phone calls not being answered and four wheeler not being able to reach his house due to road construction work, he and his wife left the house for Meera Talkies so that he could go to the function alongwith his son Chhotu. When he alongwith his wife reached 10-20 steps before Meera talks saw that four young men were riding on two bikes next to us due to which one Tushar Kumar, Shivam Kumar and Rohit Kumar alongwith unknown person passed him very fist and his son was standing near his new Thar four wheeler and was talking to his friends Gandhi Yadav and Roshan Singh @ Roshan Don. Both the motor-cycles stopped there and Tushar Kumar got down first and shot his son in the back from behind. After that Shivam Kumar also got down and shot him in the face. Then Rohit Kumar and the unknown person also started firing at his son. When his son fell unconscious they started kicking him. After that both criminals turned their bikes and another unknown persons started coming toward us and kept running straight in which people identified three of them again Shivam Kumar, Tushar Kumar and Rohit Kumar all of them fled away from there. He reached near car and saw his son bleeding and started shouting. Thereafter his eldest son Ashish also arrived after someone called. He immediately rushed his son to Surya Hospital, where the Doctor declared him dead. It is further alleged that six months ago Chhotu Mishra was attacked with sticks and rods at the Saharsa Bus Stand by Golu Yadav alongwith Tushar,

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Shivam alongwith other with intention of killing. His son did not report the incident to the police. His son always told him that Golu Yadav hatched conspiracy to kill him with hired criminals.

7. The petitioner is named in FIR. The incident in question has occurred in the main market. The three FIR named accused persons including this petitioner and one another fired indiscriminately on the deceased. There is direct and specific allegation against the petitioner. the investigation of the case is still going on.

8. To unearth the whole truth the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

9. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the fact that a gruesome murder has been committed in broad day light and there is some material on record in the case diary against the petitioner, it is not a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly the instant anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner namely Shivam Kumar @ Shivam Kumar Trivedi is hereby **rejected**.
