	10.06.2026	This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely (1) Manisha Kumari @ Manisha Bharti D/o Satya Narayan Ram @ Suman Ram, (2) Geeta Devi W/o Satyanarayan Ram @ Suman Ram, (3) Prince Kumar Ram @ Prince Raj S/o Satya Narain Ram @ Suman Ram, (4) Mamta Devi W/o Chandra Kishor Ram @ Chano Ram who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. Case No. 1254/2025 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 74, 324(4), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioners that petitioners are innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge, malice, land dispute and dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that the petitioners bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that both parties are close relatives and there exists land dispute between	

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<u>Cont/2-</u> <u>10.06.2026</u>	them. It is further submitted that petitioner has no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that petitioner nos 1, 2 and 4 are ladies and petitioner no. 3 is student and they are man and weman of means and there is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the evidence and they are ready to furnish sound sureties to the learned court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case as per typed report of informant Sunita Kumari is that in the night of 27.10.2025 to 29.10.2025 some unknown thieves stolen jewelry worth Rs. 8 Lakhs from her house. Regarding this she submitted a written application on 30.10.2025 and on the basis of which Sadar P.S. Case No. 1223/2025 was registered. On 01.11.2025 at about 12:00 O'clock she went to Sadar P.S. Saharsa with her mother and daughter to get the photo copy fo the FIR. When she returned to her house at about 14:22 P.M. with her mother and daughter then her neighbours Satya Narayan Ram @ Suman Ram, Prince Kumar Ram, Praket Kumar Ram, Sakshi Kumari, Manisha Kumari and Geeta Devi and the tenant of Satyanarayan alongwith his wife unanimously started abusing and beating her children. When she protested then Satya Narayan Ram @ Suman Ram wrapped his towel around her neck with intention of killing started pressing her neck. When her elder daughter Abhilasha Kumari came to rescue her then Prince Kumar armed with iron rod assaulted on her head due to which she sustained injury and her head got swelled. When	
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<u>Cont/3-</u> <u>10.06.2026</u>	her second daughter Rani Kumari started making video of the abovesaid incident on her mobile then Geeta Devi, Manisha Kumari and Sakshi Kumari together beaten her daughter caught her hand and hit her and snatched her mobile and threw it due to which the screen of the mobile broken. Satya Narayan Ram threatened to face dire consequence in future and thereafter all the accused persons started assaulting by lathi danda, rod, legs and punches. On raising alarm the nearby people came there on which Satya Narayan Ram, Chano Ram and Prince Kumar threatened to kill her husband if she lodge case and also threatened to kidnap her daughter and sell her and thereafter the accused persons fled away from there. Thereafter she called on 112 and police came there. 7. The injured Abhilasha Kumari has suffered multiple scratch mark over Rt. Upper limb and the nature of injury is simple. No sign of injury over head was found in the medical examination. The second injured Rani Kumari has suffered tenderness over Rt. Elbow and the nature of injury is found to be simple caused by hard and blunt object. The petitioners bears no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 52 of the case diary. The investigation of the case can be conducted without arresting the petitioners. 8. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances, a case is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioners (1) Manisha Kumari @ Manisha Bharti, (2) Geeta Devi, (3) Prince Kumar Ram @ Prince Raj and (4) Mamta Devi is allowed and in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today, they are directed to be released on bail subject to their furnishing	
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bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned jurisdictional Magistrate where the case is presently pending, further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
