05.06.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Sudhir Paswan S/o Tileshwar Paswan @ Tilo who is in custody since 29.04.2026 in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 92/2026 registered under Sections 303(2), 317(2) of BNS, 2026. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears criminal antecedent of ten cases. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that petitioner has no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused.	

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6. The prosecution case, in brief, is that the written report of the informant Munna Kumar is that on 28.04.2026 at about 21:00 O'clock his father went to his foxnut field then saw that motor was missing. Then on the basis of suspicion of motor theft he called Md. Rizwan Ali, Md. Imtiyaz and Sudhir Paswan. When the villagers interrogated them, all the three persons admitted to stealing the motor. Thereafter the accused persons were handed over to the police. After investigation of police the said motor was recovered from the house of Sudhir Paswan.

7. The petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2026 having clean past antecedent as mentioned in para 34 of the case diary. The stolen property i.e. the water pump has already been recovered. Charge-sheet in this case has already been filed.

8. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances a case to grant bail to the petitioner is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail is **allowed**. The petitioner Sudhir Paswan be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS.
