Aurangjeb S/o Abdul Kayum</b> who is in custody since 08.04.2026 in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 81/2026 registered under Sections 303(2), 317(2) of BNS, 2023.</p> <p>2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State.</p> <p>3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 08.04.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and she has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the alleged sections are not applicable against the petitioner and she has no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is a man of means and there is no chance of his absconding</p> |                               |

Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner.</p> <p>4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.</p> <p>5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused.</p> <p>6. The prosecution case, in short as per the written report of informant Md. Asadullah is that on 07.04.2026 at about 11:15 P.M. in the night Md. Aurangjeb entered into his house and stole a Vivo mobile worth Rs. 20,000/- kept on the cupboard of the house. He saw running him but he escaped. He also stolen Vivo Mobile from the house of Md. Tanveer and a cycle from the house of Janif Khan. It is further alleged that the accused has already committed the crime and the social level also a panchayti was held in which he has admitted that he had not committed such type of mistake in future.</p> <p>7. The petitioner is in custody since 08.04.2026 having clean past antecedent as mentioned in para 20 of the case diary. Charge-sheet has already been filed in this case. The further custody of the petitioner is not required. The purpose of bail is to secure the presence of the accused to face trial.</p> <p>8. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, a case to grant bail to the petitioner accused namely Md. Aurangjeb is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail is <b>allowed</b>. The petitioner be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down</p> |  |

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under Section 480(3) of the BNSS. Further condition is that the petitioner shall remain physically present on all the dates of hearing till the charges are framed and thereafter shall remain duly represented on each and every date of hearing and shall appear physically as and when directed by the learned trial court. If the petitioner fails to abide by any terms and conditions, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

9. With the above observation the petition stands disposed of.
