	11.06.2026	This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely (1) Anakit Kumar S/o Sukkan Paswan, (2) Sukkan Paswan S/o Late Shital Paswan, (3) Sulekha Devi W/o Sukkan Paswan and (4) Puja Kumari @ Puja Devi D/o Sukkan Paswan who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mahila (Saharsa) P.S. Case No. 16/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 85, 82(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioners that petitioners are innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that the petitioners bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the informant has solemnize second marriage with another person Hareram Paswan in the year 2015. It is further submitted that petitioners are man and women of means and there is no chance of their	

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punishable upto the maximum imprisonment of three years and is triable by learned Magistrate.

8. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, no custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

9. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioners (1) **Anakit Kumar**, (2) **Sukkan Paswan**, (3) **Sulekha Devi** and (4) **Puja Kumari @ Puja Devi** is **allowed** and in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today, they are directed to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned jurisdictional Magistrate where the case is presently pending, further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
