1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Bhantu Yadav 2. Barhmi Yadav 3. Nitish Yadav and 4. Laltu Yadav**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with **Bihra P.S Case No. 112/2023** registered u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 354(B), 379, 504 and 34 of IPC.

2. The prosecution story in brief as per informant Rajendra Yadav is that on 07.06.2023, at about 06:30 PM, when he was coming back with his cattle, then her wife told him that accused/petitioners Barhmi Yadav, Bhantu Yadav and Nitish Yadav along with others have abused and beaten their son and due to which his son had become unconscious and when the wife of the informant complained to the petitioners, then the petitioners had thrown her on the ground and outraged her modesty. It has further been alleged that when informant went to the petitioners then petitioners injured and caused head injury with iron rod upon the informant.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioners and Ld. APP for the State .

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence and they have falsely been implicated in the present case and there is no any criminal antecedent against the petitioners.

5. Ld. APP opposes the bail stating that the informant has been badly injured having following injury:-

- (I) incised wound at Lt. Parietal region of size 2"x 1/2"x skin deep
- (ii) Bruise at Lt. Forearm of size 2" x 2".

6. Considering the injury upon the vital part of the informant by sharp object **AND** direct allegation against the petitioners, this court **is not inclined** to grant **anticipatory bail** to the accused/petitioners namely 1. Bhantu Yadav 2. Barhmi Yadav 3. Nitish Yadav and 4. Laltu Yadav, hence their prayer is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
