Lawyer appearing on behalf of the accused petitioner submits before the court that the petitioner is a student used to reside in different station for his study and there has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further argued that during investigation the medical report shows that no any sign of injuries was seen over the vaginal or any private part. No any spermatozoa was seen in vaginal swab examination. The Id. Lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner further argued on this point that the factum of rape has been negated clinically by the medical report, hence prayer is made to enlarge the petitioner on bail.</p> <p>The Id. APP opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail and argued in such type of heinous offences Anticipatory Bail should not be granted.</p> <p>Having heard both side, perused the case record and found that in the FIR the informant specifically alleged that it is the petitioner Nitish Kumar who has by forcely committed rape with her in mid-night.
