09/07/2026	Two bail applications one B.A No- 355/2026 filed by the Baijnath Mandal @ Baidynath Mandal and another B.A No. 354/2026 filed by the Sagar Kumar is put up for hearing together as both the bail application are arises out of Kashnagar P.S Case no. 25/2026, u/s- 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 125, 121(1), 121(2), 109, 324(4), 324(5), 132 & 3(5) of BNS. The substances of the argument of both the petitioners is that there was minor scuffle between public and police officials and the instant case has been instituted by the police officials only with a view to teach lessons to the villagers. It is further submitted by him that it is alleged that although the petitioners along with more than 100 persons have attack the police officials but in fact no any alleged occurrences has been taken place which would evident from the injury report available on record which shows that some of the police officials has complained only pain in his body which is no injury in the eye of law, hence prayer is made to enlarge the petitioners on regular bail. Ld. A.P.P opposed the prayer of regular bail of the petitioners. Having heard both sides, perused the case record and found that the instant FIR has been lodged on the basis of the statement of one Sub-inspector of police namely Shivjee Singh posted at Kashnagar police station at that time. He alleged that during patrolling several persons named in the FIR have attacked on police officials due to which police

On the statement of Chowkidar the name of the accused persons given in the FIR. From perusal of the case record it appears that both the petitioners were not put on T.I.P even though both remained in custody for more than one month. No any serious injuries is available on record and the injuries casued is simple in nature. So, considering the facts and circumstances of the case the bail application no. 355/2026 filed by the Baijnath Mandal @ Baidynath Mandal and the bail application no. 354/2026 filed by Sagar Kumar is hereby allowed and both the petitioners are directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond 4,000 with one surity of like amount.
