Case No. 24/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioners that petitioners are in custody since 14.05.2026. It is further submitted that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to suspicion. It is further submitted that the alleged sections are not applicable against the petitioner and he has no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties. It is further submitted that petitioners are men of means and there is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the evidence and they are ready to	

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released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS.
