Case No. 467/2026 registered under Section 223, 308(2) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner has no manner of concern with the alleged incident and the alleged section is not applicable against him. It is further submitted that the the petitioner has filed CWJC No. 4195/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna which is pending for final adjudication. It is further submitted that the allegation of criminal threat is completely vague and no date, time and place or nature of the alleged threat is mentioned. It is further submitted that petitioner is a man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence in this case and he is ready to abide any conditions imposed by the learned court and he is also ready to cooperate in the

On the other hand, the learned P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case in nut-shell as per written report of informant District Fisheries Officer-cum-Chief Executive Officer, Saharsa has alleged in the FIR that the accused Bhogi Sahni was granted settlement of the Collectorate Fish Seed Project for a period of ten years commencing from 01.07.2026 but failed to deposit the settlement dues for the year 2022-23 and 2023-24 despite repeated notices, thereby violating the terms and conditions of the settlement. It is alleged that the Director of Fisheries, Bihar, Patna cancelled the settlement, whereafter the accused was directed on several occasion by the Commissioner, Kosi Division, Saharsa to vacate the project premises and hand over charge of the government property and assets. However, he continued in unauthorized possession thereof. It is further alleged that the accused issued threats to the concerned authorities, leading to the registration of the present case. 7. The case has been lodged against the petitioner for not complying with the terms and conditions of the agreement which was entered into between the petitioner and Fisheries Department. The FIR is silent as to whom the petitioner gave threats. It is also not mentioned as to on what date and at which place the alleged threats were given. All the witnesses are the high ranking officials of Government therefore, it is highly unlikely that the petitioner would be able to influence them. The case is based on documentary evidence which is already in the possession of the investigating agency. 8. For the purpose of investigation, the custodial

9. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, a case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. Resultantly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner Bhogi Sahni is **allowed** and in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, he is directed to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned jurisdictional Magistrate where the case is presently pending. This order is further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
