1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1.Chhavi Priya**, who apprehends her arrest in connection with **Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 08/2025** registered u/s 126(2), 115, 303(2), 82, 85, 352, 351(3) and 3(5) of BNS and $\frac{3}{4}$ of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. The brief allegation in the FIR against the petitioner is that she has solemnized second marriage with the main accused Sonu Jha, who along with his family member had tourchered and demanded dowry from the informant wife.

3. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused/husband Sonu Jha has been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 22.01.2026 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 38764 of 2025, and other accused i.e. in-laws have been granted bail by court of Ld. District & Additional Session Judge. He further submits that the only allegation against the petitioner is that she has solemnized second marriage with the accused Sonu Jha, apart from this, there is no other allegation.

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail of the accused.

Considering not much allegation against the accused/petitioner, the prayer of anticipatory bail for accused/petitioner Chhavi Priya is **allowed** and she shall be **released on bail** in the event of her arrest **or** surrender **within six weeks** before the concern trial court with two sureties of Rs. 10000/- of like amount.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
