	19.06.2026	This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Raj Kishor Yadav @ Kishor S/o Late Kapleshwar Yadav who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. Case No. 1299/2025 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 119(1), 324(4), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge, malice and dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that the petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties. It is further submitted that sections 119(1), 303(2) of BNS are added to make the case graver and non-bailable. It is further submitted that petitioner is posted as ASI at Begusarai and neither he is named in the FIR nor he has concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this court in A.B.A. No. 139/2026 vide order dated	

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<u>Cont/2-</u> <u>19.06.2026</u>	05.05.2026 and the case of petitioner stands on same footing. It is further submitted that there is delay of six days in lodging the FIR. It is further submitted that petitioner is ready to abide all the terms and conditions imposed by the court and he is also ready to furnish sound sureties to the satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case as per written report of informant Chandkishore Yadav is that on 10.11.2025 at about 12:30 O'clock he was harvesting paddy crop in his field then Gopal Yadav, Gobind Yadav, Rajo Yadav and Bhukhni Devi armed with deadly weapons came there and told him to registered the said land in their name otherwise he will be killed. When he objected then Gopal Yadav armed with iron Dabiya assaulted on his head with intention of killing but he tried to save himself due to which he sustained injury on his hand. All the accused persons assaulted him by fists and kicks and threatened him to not to come in the said field. A panchayati was convened in village but no one of the village has come in the panchayti due to fear. On 17.11.2025 the accused persons forcibly plough the said land. The accused persons have previously demanded ransom for which Saharsa Sonbarsa Kachahari P.S. Case No. 825/2025 was lodged against them. 7. The name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR. The name of the petitioner first time came in the supervision note and from the

supervision note, it is not clear from what basis the supervising officer has stated that the incident has occurred at the instance of the petitioner. There is an unexplained delay of nine days in lodging the FIR. No injury report is brought into the notice of this court. The FIR named accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide order dated 05.05.2026 passed in A.B.P. No. 139/2026. The petitioner is having clean past antecedent.

8. Considering the totality of facts and circumstances, a case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner Raj Kishor Yadav @ Kishor is **allowed** and in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, he is directed to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned jurisdictional Magistrate where the case is presently pending. This order is further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
