	10.06.2026	This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely (1) Rajendra Das S/o Late Kukar Das, (2) Nakul Das @ Das Nakalu S/o Rajendra Das and (3) Ranjay Sharma @ Ranjay Das S/o Anurudh Das @ Anirudh Sharma who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Simri Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 95/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 110, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioners that petitioners are innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 bears criminal antecedent one case whereas petitioner no. 3 bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and both parties are close relatives. It is further	

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<u>Cont/2-</u> <u>10.06.2026</u>	submitted that petitioners are men of means and there is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the evidence and they are ready to furnish sound sureties to the learned court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case as per written report of informant Devki Devi is that on 29.03.2026 at about 06:00 P.M. in the evening when she was at her house. In the meantime Rajendra Das, Ranjay Das, Nakul Das, Sangeeta Devi, Kanchan Devi and Bhola Das armed with lathi danda came at her house and started assaulting with filthy words and said that the application she has filed in the police station should be withdrawn. On which she objected then all the accused persons assaulted indiscriminately on her back, ribs and chest by lathi danda and rod. When her daughter Nibha Kumari came to rescue her then she was also assaulted by Ranjay Kumar by iron rod due to which her head got lacerated and blood started oozing and she fell down on the ground. In the meantime Sangeeta Devi and Kanchan Devi snatched gold Chakti and gold chain worth rs. 35,000/- from her neck. With the help of nearby people the injured persons were brought to Hospital. 7. The alleged incident had occurred to pressurize the informant to withdraw the case which the informant has lodged for allegedly beating the son of the informant. The accused persons have inflicted two injuries on the head of injured Nibha Kumari who is aged about 13 years only. The first injury is lacerated wound on	
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head size of 2''x 1'' and the another injury is swelling on occipital region 2'' x ½''. Though the injuries are simple in nature. However repeated blow is given on the vital part of the injured who is of merely 13 years of age. From the manner of assault common intention is apparently present.

8. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and more particularly the age of injured, no case is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, the anticipatory bail application of petitioners (1) Rajendra Das (2) Nakul Das @ Das Nakalu and (3) Ranjay Sharma @ Ranjay Das is hereby **rejected**.
