B.A- 403/2026, filed by the Prince Kumar @ Prince Mishra Vs State of Bihar 3. B.A- 410/2026, filed by Navneet Kumar Vs State of Bihar 4. B.A- 445/2026, filed by the Akshay Kumar @ Raja Tiwari Vs State of Bihar & 5. B.A- 534/2026, filed by Diwakar Suman @ Babu Saheb Vs State of Bihar, have been filed. All the aforesaid bail applications are arises out of Saharsa Sadar P.S Case no. 278/2026, u/s- 25(1-B), 26, 35 of Arms Act, for alleged recovery of following Arms and ammunitions. 1. One 9 mm automatic pistol made in U.S.A 2. One 9 mm automatic pistol made in Bulgaria. 3. Automatic Pistol no. 1111 made in U.S.A only U.S.A supply. 4. One Pistol no. 1111 made in U.S.A only Itlay supply. 5. One black colour revolver. 6. One Desi Katta and several magazines and catridges along with dagger. It is argued on behalf of the petitioners that all the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case. It is	

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further argued that all the petitioners are students, hence they may be enlarged on regular bail.

The Ld. A.P.P opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard both sides, perused the case record. From perusal of the case record it appears that earlier on 14.03.2023 one Chhotu Mishra was murdered for which Saharsa Sadar Police Station case no- 273/2026 has been instituted. During course of investigation it has been detected that the named accused of that case Rohit Kumar @ Mitthu was hiding himself in one village of Supaul, thereafter a raid was conducted and Rohit Kumar @ Mitthu was apprehended there and he confessed his complicity in the murder of Chhotu Mishra and also stated that his friends 1. Tushar Kumar, 2. Yug Kumar, 3. Prince Kumar @ prince Mishra, were his associates. He has also stated that the arms and ammunitions which were used in that occurrence have been supplied by Navneet Kumar @ Uday and Diwakar Suman @ Babu Saheb and after the completion of murder they have handed over that arms to Abhimanyu Kumar and upon his information one by one several persons have been interrogated and they have successively confessed their guilt and made disclosure statement that all the arms were kept concealing in a Gym and upon their confessional-cum-disclosure statement 05 foreign made automatic pistol with catridges, one country made pistol and catridges alongwith dagger have been recovered from that gym in

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secretly concealed position. Although the alleged foreign made huge arms and ammunitions were recovered from the Gym of Saurav Kumar Mishra but that recovery was made on the basis of statement of the aforesaid accused persons named above and all were conscious about that arms as intention to possess and knowledge and control over that arms exists in this case. So from the material available on record and considering the facts that 05 foreign made automatic pistol, one country made pistol, several ammunitions and one dagger itself indicates that all the aforesaid accused persons were member of a gang of criminals. If such persons are allowed on bail it will very likely that they may commit similar offence of like nature or more serious offences, as apprehended by the Ld. APP. So, considering the facts and circumstances of the case and its likely effects on society and administrations, I am of considered opinion that the aforesaid accused persons do not deserve to be enlarged on bail because it is the arms which is source and means of almost every offences in society, therefore all the aforesaid bail applications filed by the accused petitioners stands **rejected**.
