The present bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner Suman Sah @ Bajrangi who is in custody since 04.03.2026 in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. case no.- 55/2026 registered U/S. 25(1-B)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act. The record has been been put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri Raj Kumar, learned counsel for petitioner and Sri Sadanand Yadav learned A.P.P for the State. 3. The case of prosecution in brief as per written information of ASI Arun Kumar is that on 15.01.2026 he along with other police personnel were on raid and for investigation in connection with Sadar PS Case No.- 54 of 2026 and in said course at about 22:10 hours when reached near the house of Lalan Kumar saw a person standing beside a black colour pulsar motorcycle who having seen the police tried to escape leaving the said motorcycle and managed to escape on account of darkness and narrow path. Further having seen the activities of police nearby people present at the place of occurrence disclosed the identity of said person who escaped as Suman Sah @ Bajrangi, s/o- Shankar Sah r/o- Kahra, ps- Saharsa, Dist-Saharsa. Further one of the witness Lalan Kumar has stated that he has seen said Suman Sah @ Bajrangi use to come to the room of one Ashutosh Kumar who is his tenant and further stated that he has seen that alleged motorcycle is being used by Suman @ Bajrangi. Further the said Pulsar motorcycle bearing Reg. No.- BR19V6125 having chesis no.- MD2A13EX4PCD79485, Engine no.- DKXCPD21914 and the alleged room of Ashutosh Kumar were searched and from the said motorcycle a country-made pistol having a cartridge mentioning 8mm KF have been recovered, however, no incriminating article has been recovered from the room of Ashutosh Kumar.	

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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is having thirteen criminal antecedents and further he submitted that petitioner has not filed any application for bail in this Court or to the Hon'ble High Court rather this is the first regular bail application being filed in this Court. Further he submitted that petitioner has not been arrested on the spot. Further he submitted that petitioner in custody since 04.03.2026 and hence his prayer for bail may be allowed.

5. Learned APP opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Perused the record. On perusal of the record it appears that petitioner is named in the FIR and there is specific allegation against him that he was with a motorcycle from which a loaded country-made pistol has been recovered. Although he has manage to escape but he has been identified by the witnesses whose statement were mentioned in para-10 and 11 of the case diary. Further seizure list is mentioned in para-61 in the case diary and the alleged motorcycle he said to be of standing in the name of one Rajesh Kumar and the same is being used by Suman Bajrangi regularly which is evident from para-82 and 84 of the case diary. Beside it from para- 89 of the case diary it transpires that the accused petitioner is having long chain of criminal antecedents of ten cases including cases under the Arms Act.

7. Consequently, considering the aforesaid facts and also the nature of injury, the prayer for regular bail of petitioner **Suman Sah @ Bajrangi** is hereby stands **rejected**.
