30/06/2026	Heard both sides on the Regular Bail Application of the accused petitioner Meera Yadav, in connection with Spl. Case No- 398/2017, u/s- 302, 120B, of IPC & u/s- 3(ii)(v) of Sc/St Act. The Ld. Lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits before the court that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offences at all. It is further submitted by him that in this case charges were framed on dated 06.04.2026. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.03.2026. The petitioner has no any criminal antecedent, hence prayer is made to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The ld. SPP opposed the prayer of Regular Bail. Having heard both sides, perused the case record and found that as per the FIR informant Gulo Paswan alleges that his daughter Babita Devi had married to Meera Yadav 04 years ago. Further he has submitted that on dated 30.05.2011 accused persons namely 1. Badri Yadav, 2. Rajo Yadav, 3. Shankar Kumar, 4. Ramsundar Devi, 5. Jawahar Yadav & 6. Meera Yadav, all conspired together and have killed his daughter Babita Devi and hidden the dead body of his daughter. The accused petitioner is in judicial custody 12.03.2026. As the allegation against the accused petitioner is very serious in nature, hence regular bail application as filed by the accused petitioner namely Meera Yadav stands rejected.
