	29.07.2026	This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely (1) Saroj Kumar S/o Ghuran Roy, (2) Sunita Devi W/o Guran Roy and (3) Ghuran Roy S/o Late Mallu Roy who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bihra P.S. Case No. 16/2026 registered under Sections 80, 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioners that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners have no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that the petitioners have never demanded any dowry from the deceased. It is further submitted that there is no evidence to show that the petitioners have committed the said incident. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case as emerges from the written report of informant Revti Devi is that the marriage of her daughter Anita Devi was solemnized with Saroj Kumar three years ago. After six months of marriage the husband of her daughter alongwith her in-laws started abusing with filthy

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words. Her son in law has been married twice before and has left his first wife. It is further alleged that her son-in-law and and the mother-in-law of deceased always demanded dowry from her daughter telling her to take her away or else bring the money. On 12.01.2026 at about 08:00 P.M. in the night her younger daughter Asha Kumari called her and said that Anita Devi is admitted in Surya Hospital, Saharsa after consuming poison and in the morning of 14.01.2026 Anita Devi died. It is further alleged that Saroj Kumar and Ghuran Roy killed her daughter Anita Devi by administering poison.

7. The petitioners Saroj Kumar, Sunita Devi and Ghuran Roy are the husband, mother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased respectively. The marriage of the deceased was solemnized with petitioner No. 1 Saroj Kumar three years ago from the date of incident.

8. The case is registered on the basis of fardbeyan of informant Revti Devi, the mother of the deceased.

9. The death is otherwise than under normal circumstances. The death is within seven years of marriage. There are allegations of demand of money from the deceased. The deceased had died at her matrimonial home.

10. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the custodial interrogation of the petitioners are required.

11. In view of the facts and circumstances, no case is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly the instant anticipatory bail petition of petitioners namely (1) Saroj Kumar, (2) Sunita Devi and (3) Ghuran Roy is hereby **rejected**.
