1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Kamal Sada and 2. Brahmdeo Yadav**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with **Saharsa Sadar P.S Case No. 635/2025** registered u/s 316(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2) and 3(5) of BNS.

2. The prosecution story in brief as per informant Bal Krishna Yadav is that he purchased a piece of land from Suresh Touti, wherein petitioner no. 1 Kamal Sada is the identifier and petitioner no. 2 Brahmdeo Yadav is the middle man. It has further been alleged that said registered sale has been declared fake and forged.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioners and Ld. APP for the State.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. He further submits that the petitioner no. 1 Kamal Sada is simply identifier and has no role in the present case and there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioners.

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail of the petitioners.

6. Perused the record and case diary. As per material available in the case diary, it has come that petitioner Brahmdeo Yadav has shown the property document to the petitioner in his Mill in the presence of petitioner Kamal Sada. It has further come in case diary that both the

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petitioners were involved in the transaction of sale from very beginning and have been present in all dealings, which shows their involvement very ab-initio.

7. Considering the involvement of the petitioners from very beginning in sale of the land to the informant, which was later on declared as fake and forged **AND** the fact that investigation is still going on, this court **is not inclined** to grant anticipatory bail to the accused/ petitioners namely 1. Kamal Sada and 2. Brahmdeo Yadav, hence their prayer is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
