	20.08.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Pintu Sharma @ Pinnu Sharma who is in custody since 25.04.2026 in connection with Bajinathpur P.S. Case No. 66/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 76, 303(2), 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of BNS. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence at all. That earlier petitioner had not filed any bail petition, nor such prayer is pending anywhere except the present prayer. That there is one criminal antecedent vide Bajinathpur P.S Case No. 01/2026. That no any specific allegation is against this petitioner and the petitioner is in custody without any fault. That the informant is petty contractor in Punjab Rice Mill and petitioner are labour for the informant. That the petitioner Tiko Sharma @ Surat Lal Sharma demanded his	

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<u>Cont/-2</u> 20.08.2026	labour charge from the informant taken time to time and lastly the false case has been filed against the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the Ld. A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail. 5. Rival submissions considered. Record perused. 6. The case of prosecution in brief is that one Chandradeo Sharma filed a computerized petition before the S.H.O Baijnathpur P.S. alleging therein that- on 18.04.2026, at about 11:00 O'clock in the night, the accused persons namely 1. Pintu Sharma @ Pinnu Sharma 2. Tiko Sharma 3. Laltu Sharma 4. Amit Sharma and 5. Dilo Sharma, all in furtherance of common intention, armed with Rod, Farsa, Gun, Lathi, entered into the house of informant and abused him. When informant and his son protested, then they stated that "we said to his son to keep Corax in his House" but he denied upon which Pintu Sharma @ Pinnu Sharma and Dilo Sharma gave farsa blow over the head of his son who fell him by rod and gun and fractured his left leg and injured his all body by Lathi, Rod and Gun and when his wife Kanchan Devi came to save them, all the named persons caught hold of her hair and beat her with kicks, punches and sticks and stripped	
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<u>Cont/-3</u> 20.08.2026	her naked and dragged her through the corn field and molested her. Accused Pintu Sharma snatched golden chain from the neck of his wife worth Rs. 70,000/-. Accused persons namely Dilo Sharma, Amit Sharma and Tiko Sharma entered into his house and looted two Khassi, ornaments, new cloths and cash Rs. 10,000/- totalling valued Rs. 50,000/-. On raising hue and cry, with the help of some villagers, she was hurriedly admitted to the primary health Centre, Saurbazar, where considering the serious condition, she was referred to Sadar Hospital, Saharsa, where she is undergoing treatment. It is also alleged that again again on 20.04.2026, all the accused persons abused and assaulted his wife Kanchan Devi and threatened that if she filed case against them, then they will kill the whole family. 7. Further as per FIR, it transpires that petitioner is a named accused. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other accused persons assaulted to the informant and other accused persons assaulted on the head of informant's son. Further, injury report is brought on record, from which it transpires that informant sustained following injuries- laceration of 1cm x ½ on right finger, for which doctor has opined injury is simple in nature and informant's son sustained following injury- laceration of 3cm x ½ cm on frontal region of head, for which doctor has opined injury is simple in nature. Furthermore, investigation against petitioner is completed and charge sheet has also been

filed against petitioner. Beside it petitioner is in custody since 25.04.2026. Other co-accused in this case has already enlarged on bail.

8. Considering the aforesaid fact and his custody period, the bail petition of petitioner is **allowed**. It is directed that petitioner Pintu Sharma @ Pinnu Sharma shall be released on bail on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. court below, subject to condition that he shall co-operate in the Trial and remain present on each date, and in the event of failure on the part of petitioner to appear before court on two consecutive dates, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
