1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Pankaj Yadav**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Balwahat P.S Case No. 54/2024** registered u/s 341, 342, 323, 324, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506 r/w 34 of IPC.

2. The allegation in the FIR as per informant Surendra Yadav is that, when he was sitting at his door, then petitioner along with other FIR named accused persons came and forcibly took his thumb impression on a plane paper. On protest co-accused gave a dabiya blow over the head of the informant, after then the petitioner along with others attacked and assaulted him by means of of iron rod resulting into several injuries. There are further allegation of snatching valuables and cash.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the State.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused Sudhir Yadav has been granted bail by Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 09.05.2025 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 5610 of 2025 and there is no any criminal antecedent against the petitioner.

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail stating that supplementary injury report given by Sub-Division Hospital, Simri Bakhtiyapur, Saharsa, stating that there is **fracture of Tibia & Fibula** and **injury no. 3 and 4 are grievous in nature** and informant Sulo Yadav was referred

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to higher centre i.e. Sadar Hospital, Saharsa, from where he has further been referred to higher centre for further treatment and diagnosis, whose report is still awaiting.

6. Considering the nature of injury **AND** the fact that the informant/injured has been referred to higher centre for further examination and diagnosis **AND** considering the nature of injury inflicting by the petitioner, this court **is not inclined** to grant anticipatory bail to the accused/petitioner namely 1. **Pankaj Yadav**, hence his prayer is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
