	24.07.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely, (1) Md. Rizwan S/o Md. Kudus and (2) Md. Imtiyaj S/o Md. Jasim who are in custody since 29.04.2026 in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 92/2026 registered under Sections 303(2), 317(2) of BNS. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioners that petitioners are in custody since 29.04.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner no. 1 Md. Rizwan bears criminal antecedent of two cases whereas petitioner no.2 Md. Imtiyaz has no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. It is further submitted that petitioners are men of means and there is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the evidence and they are ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioners.	

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<u>Cont/2-</u> <u>24.07.2026</u>	4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case, in brief, is that the written report of the informant Munna Kumar is that on 28.04.2026 at about 21:00 O'clock his father went to his foxnut field then saw that motor was missing. Then on the basis of suspicion of motor theft he called Md. Rizwan Ali, Md. Imtiyaz and Sudhir Paswan. When the villagers interrogated them, all the three persons admitted to stealing the motor. Thereafter the accused persons were handed over to the police. After investigation of police the said motor was recovered from the house of Sudhir Paswan. 7. The petitioners are in custody since 29.04.2026. The allegation against the petitioners are that they had stolen the water pump of the informant and the water pump has already been recovered from the house of Sudhir Paswan at the instance of these petitioners. The custody of the petitioners are no longer required as the charge-sheet in the case has already been filed. The co-accused Sudhir Paswan has already been granted bail by this court vide order dated 05.06.2026 passed in B.A. No. 323/2026. 8. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances, a case to grant bail to the petitioners is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail of petitioners is allowed. The petitioners namely (1) Md. Rizwan and (2) Md. Imtiyaj be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS. Further condition that the petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall remain physically present till the charges

framed and thereafter the petitioners shall remain duly represented on each and every date of hearing and shall appear in person as and when required to do so by the learned trial court. The failure on the part of the petitioners to comply with the above conditions may result in cancellation of the petitioners by the learned trial court itself.
