This criminal revision has been filed on behalf of petitioners named above and is directed against the order dated 05.05.2025 (hereinafter referred to as impugned order) passed by the learned S.D.M. Samastipur in M.R. No. 732 of 2025 whereby and whereunder the Ld. Court has initiated a proceeding under Section 163 of the B.N.S.S and further directed both the parties of the proceeding not to go over the disputed land till further order as

also directed both the parties to appear in the court on 13.05.2026 and file show cause as to why not prohibitory order with respect to disputed land be made absolute.

2. Record called out.
3. On call Ld. Lawyer of petitioners as well as Ld. Lawyer of O.P.No.2 appeared. Ld. P.P is already present.
4. Heard Dr. Arvind Kumar Jha-learned counsel for the petitioners, Sri Shivam Kumar-learned counsel of the O.P.2nd.Party and also heard Sri Shiv Kumar Prasad-learned P.P for the State.
5. It appears that the impugned order has lost its force. The impugned order has been passed on 05.05.2026 and according to Section 163(4) of the B.N.S.S any order passed under Section 163 B.N.S.S expires after sixty days.
