The present claim petition has been filed by the claimant/petitioner under the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for seeking compensation.

2. File taken up in National Lok Adalat being held today. In view of the statements of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.3/insurance company, which have been recorded today separately, the matter has been compromised between the parties. Heard. Accordingly, an award for the recovery of ₹2,40,000/- is passed in favour of the claimant in full and final settlement of his claim. The amount shall be payable by respondent No.3 i.e. the insurance company to the claimant/petitioner within a period of sixty days failing which the same shall be paid with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the petition till realization.

3. In compliance of orders dated 16.3.2021 passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No.534/2020 titled as Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Private Ltd. Vs. Union of India & Ors., the amount awarded shall be deposited directly in SBI Bank A/c No.38139416295, IFSC:SBIN0006615, Branch Code:6615 Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Kurukshetra, by way of RTGS or NEFT. Accordingly, instant claim petition stands allowed pursuant to settlement, with no order as to costs.
