This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner **Guddu Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Karpoorigram P.S. Case No.-86/2025** registered u/s.-294(2)A, 77, 79, 308(3), 108, 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita and Sec.7, 66(E), 67(A) of I.T. Act. Heard both the sides on bail petition.

The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that no other bail application except this is pending before any other court and he has further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to village politics. The ld. Counsel has further submitted that the informant of this case is characterless lady due to which her husband suicide in Tamil Nadu. The ld. Counsel has further submitted that the informant and petitioner are family

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members and due to land dispute in between both the parties, this false case has been lodged against the petitioner. The ld. Counsel has further submitted that the deceased has committed suicide in Tamil Nadu, case should have been lodged in Magamalai police but case lodged in Karpoorigram Police station, this shows that the entire investigation is wrong. The ld. Counsel has further submitted that the petitioner has got no any criminal history. Accordingly, the ld. Counsel has prayed to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner.

On the other hand, the Ld. A.P.P for the state has opposed the prayer of the bail. The ld. APP has further submitted that there is sufficient material available in the case diary to support the allegation against the petitioner and video is said to be got viral in village Shambhupatti, P.S.-Karpoorigram which falls within the Jurisdiction of local police. Accordingly, it has been prayed that the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner may be rejected.

Heard and perused the case record and case diary.

From Perusal of Case record it appears that the F.I.R. has been lodged in connection with **Karpoorigram P.S. Case No.-86/2025** registered u/s.-294(2)A, 77, 79, 308(3), 108, 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita and Sec.7, 66(E), 67(A) of I.T. Act. The prosecution story in brief as per F.I.R. is that on 08.07.2025, the informant received calls from unknown numbers demanding Rs.20,000/-, threatening to viral objectionable videos and photos of her and her husband. Some videos were also shared in village whatsapp groups. Due to this activity, her husband committed suicide in Tamil Nadu and for this UD case no. 259/2025 has already been registered at P.S.-Thogamalai, Distt.-Karur, Tamil Nadu. It has also been alleged that the caller numbers was 8587056253 and 983566842. It has also been alleged that after death of husband of informant bhaipur and father-in-

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16.07.2026 law are regularly threatening the informant to kill, therefore, she has presented application before police after delay.

On perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is not the holder of mobile no. from which message is said to be communicated to informant. Further, it also appears that alleged obscene materials has also not been procured by the I.O. Other co-accused persons have been enlarged bail by the Hon'ble court, investigation against the petitioner is complete and charge-sheet has already been submitted. Petitioner claims no any criminal antecedent.

Therefore, considering the above said facts and circumstance of the case, the bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner is hereby **allowed** and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. Trial Court subject to condition laid down under section 480(3)(a)(b)(c) of BNSS.
