ORDER

The present regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely **1. Shravan Kumar Jha 2. Harshvardhan Kumar Jha @ Ankit Kumar Jha** in connection with Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 121 of 2026 under Sections- 329(4), 115(2), 126(2), 109, 74, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S.

As per the F.I.R., the prosecution story, in brief, is as follows-

The informant Ram Shankar Jha stated in his application that on 21.03.2026 at about 07:00 AM, he was sitting at his house. All FIR named accused persons came on a motorcycle, armed with iron rod, lathis and other weapons. They have assaulted him and his family members causing seirous injuries. They have dragged informant's daughter-in-law by her hair. They outraged her modesty. They have threatened to kill the family if they filed a case against them. In the background of aforesaid incident, the instant case has been lodged.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners has submitted that no anticipatory or regular bail petition has ever been moved or pending or has been disposed of either by the Ld. Court of DAJ Rosera, or by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has three criminal antecedents. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.03.2026. The petitioners are quite innocent and committed no offences. The petitioners are ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the learned court. There is no chance of their absconding or tempering with the evidence. So, he prays to enlarge the accused petitioners on bail.

On the other hand Ld. APP on behalf of state opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides. On perusal of the record, it appears that there are allegations of assault by means of iron-rod, lathi and pistol against the accused petitioners. According to para 116 of the case diary 03 criminal cases are pending against the petitioners. The injury report of Raja Ram Jha is available on the record. According to this injury report, a lacerated wound has been found at right palm which is greivious in nature. No other injury report has been submitted by the I.O. From the

injury report, it is pretty clear that no injury was sustained on the sensitive and vital organ of the injured. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 25.03.2026. The charge-sheet has already been submitted against the petitioners.

Considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and period of custody of the petitioners, this court is inclined to released the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the petitioners, namely **1. Shravan Kumar Jha 2. Harshvardhan Kumar Jha @ Ankit Kumar Jha** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each with the satisfaction of the Id. court below. One of the bailors shall be a close relative to the petitioners.
