ORDER

1. The present petition has been filed by the accused petitioners, namely Raj Kumar Mandal and Mina Devi seeking bail as they have been in custody since 23.04.2026 in connection with Shivjinagar P.S. Case No. 115 of 2025, registered under Sections 137 (2), 96, 3 (5) of the B.N.S.
2. Briefly stated, the case of the prosecution based upon the written application of the informant, namely, Shyam Sunder Mahto, is that on 26.11.2025, at about 9.00 A.M. his daughter namely, Mini Kumari aged about 14 years who was student in class VII, went to Middle School Parwana for studying but she did not return till 04.00 P.M. Thereafter, they started searching her and during course of search, he came to know that Raushan Mandal lured the informant's daughter and took away with him. It is alleged that Accused (1) Phulo Mandal, (2) Anita Devi, (3) Rakesh Kumar, (4) Rajnish Kumar, (5) Rajkumar Mandal and (6) Meena Devi - all hatched a conspiracy in kidnapping of his daughter in which accused Anita Devi and Rakesh Kumar had played main role.
3. Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners has submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics and pre-enmity. No regular or anticipatory bail petition was ever filed or pending in the Court of District & Sessions Judge, Samastipur, A.D.J.-1 Rosra or Camp Court Rosera or in the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the F.I.R. has been registered U/s 137 (2), 96, 3 (5) of B.N.S. which is not made out against these petitioners. The entire allegations against the petitioners are false, baseless and concocted. It is further submitted that there is no chance of absconding and tempering with the evidence. The petitioners undertake to abide by all terms and conditions as mentioned under Section 480(3) of BNSS.
4. On the other hand Ld. APP. on behalf of state opposed the prayer for bail.
5. Perused the records. The present case has been instituted against the accused including the present petitioners under Sections 137 (2), 96, 3 (5) of the B.N.S. on the allegation that they kidnapped the informant's daughter namely, Mini Kumari. Perusal of the case diary reveals the victim has been recovered during the course of investigation. In her statement recorded under Section 183 of BNSS, she has stated that she left her home and went to Delhi on 26.11.2025 on account of her father constantly rebuking her for her being poor in study. She

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began doing job in Delhi. She has denied that she was kidnapped by anyone. Present petitioners are parents of the accused Roushan Mandal who is accused of having enticed away the victim. They have been in custody since 23.04.2026. Victim has refused to undergo medical test.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case including the period of custody and statement of the victim, it appears that further custody of the petitioners shall serve no useful purpose and it appears that it would be appropriate to grant bail to the present petitioners.
7. Accordingly, the petitioners, namely Raj Kumar Mandal and Mina Devi are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of the Ld. Magistrate concerned in connection with **Shivajinagar P.S. Case No. 115 of 2025, subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 480(3) of BNSS.**
8. Let a copy of this order along with the LCR be sent to the Court of the Ld. Magistrate concerned.
