ORDER

The present petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely **Tannu Singh @ Sonu Singh** in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 105 of 2026 under Sections- 317(5), 318(4) of B.N.S.

As per the F.I.R., the prosecution story, in brief, is as follows-

The informant Sub-Inspector, Dharmendra Kumar of Hasanpur P.S. stated in his application that on 10.04.2026, at about 05:00 PM, during partolling duty and vehicle checking near Atapur Durga Chowk, Hasanpur police found an old Hero motorcycle without a registration number plate. Priyanshu Kumar, who was found in possession of the vehicle, stated that it belongs to his friend Tannu Singh @ Sonu Singh and had been given to him for its repair. However, no documents of the vehicle was produced. The Chassis number as well as the engine number of the motorcycle were tampered and erased. The recovered motorcycle has been seized and a seizure list was prepared. Priyanshu Kumar and Tannu Singh @ Sonu Singh were arrested for keeping a stolen motorcycle. In the background of aforesaid incident, the instant case has been lodged.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that no anticipatory or regular bail petition has ever been moved or pending or has been disposed of either by the Ld. Court of DASJ Rosera, or by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent vide Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 06/2024 under excise Act. The petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. From persaul of the F.I.R., your honour would be satisfied that the seized article was recovered from co-accused Priyanshu Kumar and on his statement petitioner's name came in this case. The petitioner is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the court. There is no chance of his absconding or tempering with the evidence. Therefore, the bail may be granted to the petitioner.

On the other hand Ld. APP on behalf of state opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides. Perused the record. The informant has himself admitted in the FIR that the motorcycle alleged to be stolen was recovered from the possession of

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the co-accused person Priyanshu Kumar. No such document is available on the record which suggests that the recovered motorcycle, anyway, concerned with the accused petitioner. According to para 30 of the case diary, sole criminal case is pending against the accused petitioner.

Considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to be released the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, namely **Tannu Singh @ Sonu Singh** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the satisfaction of the Id. court below subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.
