ORDER

1. The present petition has been filed by the accused petitioner, namely, Shivchandar Sahni seeking bail as he has been in custody since 31.03.2026 in connection with Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 474 of 2025, registered under Sections 334 (2), 303 (2) of BNS.
2. Briefly stated, the case of the prosecution based upon the written application of the informant, namely, Rajiv Kumar, who is running a jewellery shop which is situated at Kalyanpur Mahavir Chowk. It has been alleged that on Friday, dated 21.11.2025, the informant closed his shop at about 7:00 PM and returned to his house. On the following day, i.e., Saturday at about 8:00 AM, he was informed by his landlord that the lock of his shop had been broken. Upon receiving such information, the informant immediately rushed to his shop and found that the lock of the shop had been cut open. On entering the shop, he noticed that the shutter lock had been broken and approximately 40–50 grams of gold ornaments and about 4 to 4.5 kilograms of silver ornaments kept in the shop were stolen. It has been further alleged that the said occurrence was captured in the CCTV cameras installed in the shop which had been destroyed and hard disk of the CCTV had been taken by the thieves.
3. Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. A.B.P. No. 336/2026 was filed in the Court of learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Samastipur and the same bail petition was transferred to Court of A.D.J.-I Rosera and was withdrawn on 01.04.2026. No other bail petition was ever filed in any higher Court or pending anywhere. Petitioner is an accused of Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 283/25, U/s 331 (4), 305 BNS. Petitioner has been in custody since 31.03.2026 It is further submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case at the instance of enemies and entire allegation are false and baseless and concocted. It is further submitted that petitioner has been made accused in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Govind Kumar Ray. He further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that there is no chance of absconding and tempering with the evidence. The petitioners undertake to abide by all terms and conditions as mentioned under Section 480(3) of BNSS.
4. On the other hand Ld. APP. on behalf of state opposed the prayer for bail.
5. Perusal of the records shows that the present case has been instituted against the accused including the present petitioner under Sections 334 (2), 303 (2) of BNS. on the allegation that the accused of the case including the present petitioner on the allegation that they cut open the lock of the informant's shop and took away jewellerys from there. Seizure memo

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indicates recovery of the looted items. FIR was lodged under Sections 334(2) and 303(2) of B.N.S but Chargesheet has been filed under Sections 310(2) and 317(3) of BNS against all the accused including the present petitioner. Petitioner has criminal antecedents. Co-accused facing same allegation has been denied bail earlier by this Court.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the gravity, allegation and the fact that other co-accused have been denied bail earlier by this Court, it appears that it would not be appropriate to grant bail to the present petitioner.
7. Accordingly, this petition stands rejected.
8. Let a copy of this order along with the LCR be sent to the Court of the Ld. Magistrate concerned.
