**ORDER**

The present anticipator bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely **1. Hemant Thakur 2. Yashbant Thakur 3. Naresh Thakur 4. Rama Thakur 5. Rajesh Thakur 6. Sonu Kumar Thakur 7. Monu Thakur 8. Sourav Thakur 9. Reena Devi 10. Indu Devi** in connection with Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 205 of 2025 under Sections- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 74, 110, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

As per the F.I.R., the prosecution story, in brief, is as follows-

The informant Sindhu Devi has stated in her application that on 25.05.2025 at about 05 PM, her neighbours, alongwith their family members, who are named in FIR attacked with an intention to kill them. They have abused and assaulted her and her family members, casuing serious injuries. They have outraged her modesty. They have snatched gold pendant and threatened to kill the entire family. In the background of aforesaid incident, the instant case has been lodged.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners has submitted that no anticipatory or regular bail petition has ever been moved or pending or has been disposed of either by the Ld. Court of DASJ Rosera, or by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedents. The petitioners are innocent and committed no offence. The petitioners are ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the learned court. There is no chance of his absconding or tempering with the evidence. Therefore, the anticipatory bail may be granted to the petitioners.

On the other hand Ld. APP on behalf of state opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides. Perused the case record. it appears there are an allegation of assault against the accused petitioners of the instant case by means of an iron-rod, lathi-danda. The accused petitioners have declared in para 03 of their bail petition that they have no criminal antecedents. The injury reports of Sindhu Devi, Gayanand Giri, Arti Devi, are described in Para 38 and the injury report of Rahul Giri is available in para 67 of the case diary. An abrasion was found over the right scapula of Sindhu Devi. An abrasion was also found over the left ring finger and pain lumber spine of Gayanand

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Giri. A lacerated wound over right little finger of Arti Devi. Aforesaid, the injuries were simple in nature and made by hard and blunt substances. 03 lacerated wounds have been found on the right palm, right knee of Rahul Giri. Swelling and pain of left leg was also found on the body of Rahul Giri. The opinion about the injury was kept reserved by the doctor. The allegations against the petitioners are omnibus in nature. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of any of the petitioners. No injury was inflicted on any vital organ of the injured. As such, this court is inclined to release the petitioners on an anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, **1. Hemant Thakur 2. Yashbant Thakur 3. Naresh Thakur 4. Rama Thakur 5. Rajesh Thakur 6. Sonu Kumar Thakur 7. Monu Thakur 8. Sourav Thakur 9. Reena Devi 10. Indu Devi** are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the satisfaction of the Id. court below subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.
