State vs. Deep Narayan Yadav.

Later on 09-05-2019	<p>Case called out both the parties appeared in the court. Sole accused namely, Deep Narayan Yadav of this case is also physically present in the court with their Ld. Advocate. Record is produced for the order in the light of compromise.</p> <p>Heard both the parties on the point of compromise and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record it transpires that on 04-08-2017 substance of accusation explained against the accused persons namely, Deep Narayan Yadav for the offences punishable under section 341,323,504 of the Indian Penal Code in Hindi to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.</p> <p>On March 06, 2018 a compromise petition on behalf of all the parties is filed before the court which is duly signed by both the parties and also in order and placed on the record. A permission petition for seeking compromise is also filed by the informant/victim namely, Minti Devi which is in order and placed on the record.</p> <p>Both victims of this case are examined in the court on the behalf of the Prosecution as P.W. 1- Minti Devi (Informant) and P.W.2- Pankaj Kumar Yadav (Son of the informant) in the light of compromise on 04-07-2018 and 09-04-2019 respectively. The above named both victim of this case have accepted the factum of compromise in their statements in their evidence.</p> <p>The substance of accusation explained against the above named accused persons for the offences punishable under sections 341,323,504 read with section of the Indian Penal Code. Offence punishable under sections 341,323, 504 are compoundable offence under the provision of sub-section (1) of section 320 of Cr.p.c.</p> <p>From perusal of compromise petition dated 06-03-18 and the statement of both victims of this case namely, P.W. 1- Minti Devi (Informant) and P.W.2- Pankaj Kumar Yadav (Son of the informant) it appears that the parties have compromised the matter, entered into settlement and victims have voluntarily given their consent to compromise the matter without any force, threat, pressure etc., from any quarter whatsoever for making the joint compromise petition before this court.</p> <p>For the foregoing reasons, in my opinion, ends of justice would be met if I accept the compromise petition. Accordingly compromise petition dated 06-03-18 is here by accepted and on the basis of compromise accused person namely Deep Narayan Yadav is here by acquitted under the provision of sub- section 8 of section 320 of Cr.p.c. from all the charges. Since the accused persons are on bail,</p>	Contd.
