15.06.26	The plaintiff filed a petition dated 31.10.2025 under Order 6 Rule 17 of C.P.C. stating the amendment required to be made in the plaint in order to perused the case plaintiff pleaded for the following amendment. I. Remove the name Ram Sagar Sahni and mentioned the name as Sogarath Sahni in place of that in 2nd line of para-2 of the plaint. II. Add the word ground before fifth in 3rd line of para 2 of the plaint. III. Add the following line after the word that and before the name Sukhram in Ist line of para-4 of the plaint. Rakat Sahni died leaving behind him a son namely Sogarath Sahni who also died leaving behind him/his a son namely. IV. Remove the word "Ram" before the name Sogarath Sahni in schedule-I of the plaint. The plaintiff pleaded that the amendments are simple in nature will have no adverse effect on the outcome of the suit and are not causing any prejudice to the defendants. He also pleaded that all these errors occurred due to typographical mistake and some oversight by the learned counsel. The defendant filed rejoinder to the petition dated 16.03.2026 and pleaded that amendment petition prayed by the plaintiff is not maintainable is it changes the nature of the suit and can cause inconvenience, eventually resulting in prejudice to the interest of the defendants with these submissions he pleaded to rejected the petition. Perused the record on perused it appears that issues have already been settled in this case and the case was pending for plaintiff evidence although,

amendments if it appears necessary and it does not changes the nature of the suit and is necessary for the proper adjudication on the suit. Considering the facts stated above and applicable law thereafter the court is of considered opinion that the amendments if allowed will not change the nature of the suit and will not have any prejudicial effect on either of the parties. Therefore, the petition dated 31.10.2025 is hereby allowed. The plaintiff is directed to comply with this order within the stipulated time frame as per the scheme of Order 6 C.P.C.
