On receipt of photocopy of file alongwith order dated 05.02.2020 passed by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in FAO No.8918 of 2014 (O&M) alongwith endorsement No.132/DSJ-19 dated 27.02.2020 of Officer Incharge, Sessions Record Room-cum-ADSJ, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, same was ordered to be registered and the Ahlmad has registered it as Civil Misc.
