ORDER

11.03.2026

The anticipatory bail petition dated 02.01.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely **1. Nagina Devi, 2. Chandani Devi and 3. Dinesh Paswan @ Sadhu Jee**, in connection with Piprahi P.S. Case No. 263/2025 registered for the offence U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 117(1), 109, 352, 351(3), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S and the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution story in brief is that on 11.12.2025 at 09:30 AM the informant Ramswarth Paswan went to land for ploughing, then Dinesh Paswan, Kabutari Devi, Nandani Kumari, Kajal Kumari and two unknown accused persons came with latthis and rods and assaulted the informant then Suresh Prasad and Nagina Prasad tried to save him. They were also beaten by them. Accordingly, the F.I.R. has been instituted.

The Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that the prosecution case as alleged is false, frivolous, baseless and concocted. There is land dispute between the informant and the petitioners / accused persons. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is also submitted that the petitioners are respectable persons of the locality and sound sureties are ready to stand their bailors. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioners be allowed anticipatory bail.

The Ld. Special P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail application and stated that The petitioners have assaulted and beaten the informant and they have committed the offences U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 117(1), 109, 352, 351(3), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. Therefore, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioners / accused persons should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the F.I.R it is clear that the case has been

instituted U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 117(1), 109, 352, 351(3), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S From perusal of case record, it appears that there is land dispute between the informant and the petitioners / accused persons. The petitioners are ladies and old man. The injuries are simple in nature.. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case this Court is inclined to admit the petitioner to anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the trial court within four weeks from the date of this order the accused persons/petitioners namely, **1. Nagina Devi, 2. Chandani Devi and 3. Dinesh Paswan @ Sadhu Jee**, are directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties with condition that they will comply the conditions mentioned under section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
