CLAIM: The petition is filed U/Sec. 166 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 seeking compensation of Rs.3,00,000/- @ 18% interest along with costs. The claim was presented on 27-01-2025. The claim was valued for the reliefs and there upon an amount of Rs.2,360/- was paid as Court fee.

The claim was referred to Lok Adalat by I Addl District Judge, Hanumakonda at the request of both parties basing on the joint memo filed by the parties.

The Original Petitioner is present along with his counsel Sri. **M.Sampath**. The respondent No.3 is represented through their counsel Sri. **E.Rajashekar Reddy**. This office inquired with the parties and their counsels for the compromise. It is evident that parties voluntarily entered into the compromise. This office also perused the pleadings and material on record. The compromise found to be lawful.

AWARD U/Sec. 21 OF LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITIES ACT, 1987

1. **Respondent no. 3** agreed to pay an amount of **Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Only)** towards full and final satisfaction of the claim of the petitioners. **R3** also agreed that if it does not deposit the said amount within one month from this date, the awarded amount shall carry interest at 6% per annum from the date of this Award till the date of realization. The Court fee shall be refunded.
2. **APPORTIONMENT:** The petitioner apportioned **Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Only)**
3. **DISBURSEMENT:** Release entire amount upon deposit.
