ORDER

01.04.2026

The anticipatory bail petition dated 10.02.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely **1. Ramjanam Ray, 2. Pramod Ray, 3. Subodh Ray and 4. Mina Devi**, in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 475/2025 registered for the offence u/s 3/4 D.P. Act the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution story in brief is that the the informant Vinod Ray given an application to Sheohar Police Station and stated that the marriage of informant's daughter Gudiya kumari has been fixed with Vinod Kumar, her father has given a gold chain of Rs. 1,33,000/- and Rs. 50 thousand in cash and other accessories & furniture of rupees 1,20,000/-. Some time before the date ^{of} marriage, all F.I.R. named accused persons started to demand of Rs. 5 lac rupees and one motorcycle, then he will get marry with the girl. When he refused to do so, all the accused persons refused to marry with informant's daughter (Guriya Kumari). Accordingly, the F.I.R. has been registered.

 The Learned counsel for petitioners submitted that petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is submitted that the F.I.R. as alleged is false, frivolous, baseless and concocted. That the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and the petitioners are quite innocent. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Only oral statement of giving money by informant no documentary evidence has been produced by informant. The person to whom the money is said to be given is not the petitioner. Hence the petitioners deserve anticipatory bail.

informant have opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and stated that all the accused persons including the petitioners have demanded dowry from the informant. Hence the bail petition filed by petitioner should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the F.I.R and Lower Court Record, it is clear that the case has been instituted u/s 3/4 D.P. Act. From perusal of the F.I.R. it appears that the petitioners have no any criminal antecedent. Only oral statement of giving money by informant no documentary evidence has been produced by informant. The person to whom the money is said to be given is not the petitioner.

Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case this Court is inclined to admit the petitioner to anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the trial court within four weeks from the date of this order the accused persons / petitioners namely, **1. Ramjanam Ray, 2. Pramod Ray, 3. Subodh Ray and 4. Mina Devi**, are directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties with condition that the petitioners will comply the conditions mentioned under section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
