ORDER

1. The petitioner above named is serving judicial custody since **16.02.2026** in connection with Tariyani PS Case No.-217/2025, Dated-25.10.2025, U/section-126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.
2. The prosecution case in brief is that on 11.10.2025 at 7:00 PM in the evening the informant was returning home from his work. When in front of the house of Mahesh Baitha, he was anticipated by the Ramishwar Ram (**Petitioner**), Soman Ram and Sirchandra Ram, who were armed with deadly weapons. It is alleged that on his anticipated the accused persons above named started abusing the informant in filthy language and on his protest they started assaulted him as well. It is further come in the FIR that in course of occurrence the accused Ramishwar Ram (**Petitioner**) made assault on him with knife with an intention to commit his murder and caused injury on his chest and neck. It is stated that when the informant tried to flee away from the place of occurrence the accused Soman Ram and Sirchandra Ram got him and Ramishwar Ram (**Petitioner**) further gave blow with knife and caused injury on the chest of the informant. It is further come in the FIR that upon receiving the injury the informant got fall on the ground and thereafter the accused persons generally assaulted him with fist and legs. The contention of informant in the FIR is that the accused persons threatened him to leave his house and villagers and flee away to some other place or else. He will be eliminated. Then the accused persons took away Gold Hanumani from his neck and two thousand rupees from his pocket and flee away from

there. The further contention of informant is that thereafter the villagers took him to PHC Tariyani for administered treatment.

3. The learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offense whatsoever as alleged. Learned counsel continue to submit that the petitioner is bearing no criminal antecedent and has reasonably been implicated into instant false case on account of dirty village politics. The allegation against petitioner is false and baseless. The statement of the informant that the petitioner assaulted him with fist, slaps and knife is false. That the petitioner is not charged under Section- 303(2) of BNS.
4. The learned public prosecutor opposed the prayer for bail.
5. Heard the parties and perused the record.
6. The allegation against petitioner is of making assault on informant. At para-12 of the case diary it is stated that the present case has arisen out of land dispute between the parties. At para-29 of the case diary is the medical report. The injury sustained by the informant is simple in nature. At para-47 of the case diary it is stated that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It is submitted that the police has filed the charge-sheet bearing CS No.-701, dated-26.02.2026, under Sections-109(1), 118(1), 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.
7. Considering the nature of allegation, period of custody, and submission of charge-sheet, no any criminal antecedent of petitioner and other facts and circumstances discussed above this court is inclined to admit the petitioner to regular bail. It is therefore, ordered that upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand Rupees) with two sureties of the like amount subject to the conditions laid down U/section-480(3) of BNSS. **The petitioner shall remain physically present on each date till framing of charge.**
