**ORDER**

1. The petitioner above named is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sheohar Mahila PS Case No.-36/2025, Dated-07.07.2025, U/sections-126(2), 127(2), 69, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.
2. Heard both sides.
3. It is alleged in the FIR that on 07.07.2025, the informant's brother Raju Kumar is married with Anu Kumari, who is daughter of Ganesh Ram. The petitioner being brother-in-law used to come time to time to her house and talked with her and made physical relation with her with the false promise of marriage. On 29.03.2024 accused Praveen Kumar took her away in a hotel and made physical relation and also took her photo. It is further alleged that her father and brother went to complaint this matter to Ganesh Ram and Shakuntala Devi then they abused her father and brother and refused to marriage.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that entire allegations levelled against petitioner are false and baseless. Petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. Petitioner has got apprehension of being arrested as the offences are non-bailable. The allegation against petitioner is that he gave proposal of marriage and made physical relation with informant. Petitioner and informant's marriage was solemnized and they are living to together as husband and wife.

5. Learned P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.
6. The informant Priyanka Kumari is present in court with her father Bilasram. On inquiry she submitted that she has married with the petitioner Praveen Kumar and is living happily with him in her matrimonial home. Her father Bilasram also said on inquiry that his daughter Priyanka Kumari is living happily with the petitioner had now we have no objection with him. The petitioner Praveen Kumar is his son-in-law and he also time to time meets him and comes to his in-law's house.
7. Considering the above discussed fact, this court is inclined to admit the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Upon arrest or surrender of petitioner within fortnight, he will be released upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, subject to the conditions laid down U/section-482(2) of BNSS.
