## ORDER

23.03.2026

The bail petition dated 07.03.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Bittu Kumar**, who is in judicial custody since 10.02.2026, in connection with Tariyani P.S. Case No. 15/2026 registered for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 76, 303(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S and the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution case in brief is that on 15.01.2026 at 06:30 P.M. informant Ranjeet Kumar making "chhajja" then accused persons came and prevent him to make "chhajja". All the FIR named accused persons assaulted the informant and other members with iron rod and bricks and they were brutally injured the informant and other members of informant. Persons of vicinity came there and take away the informant and other member to P.H.C, Tariyani, where they were treated. Accordingly, the F.I.R. was got instituted.

The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence whatsoever as alleged and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The prosecution case as alleged is false, frivolous and baseless. It is submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and he has been made accused by the informant only with intention to pressurize the accused persons. There is land dispute between the parties. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.02.2026. The petitioner is a respectable person of the locality and sound sureties are ready to stand his bailors. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

That the learned Special P.P vehemently opposed the prayer for bail petition. The petitioner is not innocent and he has committed the


offence as alleged. Therefore, the bail application of the petitioner should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the case record it is clear that the case has been instituted u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 76, 303(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S. From the perusal of the case diary it appears that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and he has been made accused by the informant only with intention to pressurize the accused persons. There is land dispute between the parties. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.02.2026. The accused petitioner has no criminal incident.

Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case the accused **Bittu Kumar** is ordered to be released on bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties.
