ORDER

06.04.2026

The bail petition dated 07.03.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Suresh Singh**, who is in judicial custody since 16.02.2026, in connection with Shyampur Bhataha P.S. Case No. 40/2026 registered for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 103(1), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S and the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution case according to informant Chandan Kumar is that on 14.02.2026 at 7 PM Akash Kumar was abusing informant's uncle Bacchu Singh (deceased) and Bacchu Singh prevented Akash Kumar to abuse him then accused Suresh Singh (Petitioner) and pankaj Singh came there armed with latthi, iron rod and bricks in their hand. The accused persons assaulted informant's uncle Bacchu Singh and his uncle Bacchu Singh lying dead on the spot. Cause of dispute as stated in the FIR is alleged to have been dues of rupees of milk. Hence case U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 103(1), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. The prosecution case as alleged is false, frivolous and baseless. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to trivial matter i.e. dues of rupees of milk. The petitioner has two criminal antecedent. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.02.2026 in spite of the petitioner is 80 years old and he is suffering from venous disease. The allegation against the petitioner is of attacking with lathi but from the perusal of P.M. Report it appears that no external injury has been found on the body of deceased Bacchu Singh. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner is a respectable person of the

locality and sound sureties are ready to stand his bailors. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

That the learned Special P.P vehemently opposed the prayer for bail petition. The petitioner is not innocent and he has committed the offence as alleged. Therefore, the bail application of the petitioner should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the case record it is clear that the case has been instituted u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 103(1), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. From the perusal of the case diary it appears that the dispute arose due to trivial matter i.e. dues of rupees of milk. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.02.2026 in spite of the petitioner is 80 years old and he is suffering from venous disease. The allegation against the petitioner is of attacking with lathi but from the perusal of P.M. Report it appears that no external injury has been found on the body of deceased Bacchu Singh. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner.

Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case the accused **Suresh Singh** is ordered to be released on bail after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties.
