ORDER

The anticipatory bail petition dated 12.03.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely **1. Ramkishor Baitha, 2. Amlesh Baitha and 3. Dharmendra Baitha @ Jitendra Baitha**, in connection with Tariyani P.S. Case No. 233/2025 registered for the offence u/s 329, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 76, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution story as per the FIR is that on 17.11.2025 at about 11:00 A.M. Rinki Kumari has been misbehaved by petitioner Rambali Baitha. Rinki Kumari is the grand daughter of informant Harendra Baitha. Later, on the same day at about 07:00 P.M. all the accused persons came at the house of informant with lathi, danda and rod and started to beat and threatened them. Hence, the F.I.R. has been instituted.

The Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. The prosecution case as alleged is false, frivolous, baseless and concocted. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent and there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. The petitioners are respectable persons of the locality and sound sureties are ready to stand their bailors. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioners should be allowed anticipatory bail.

The Ld. Special P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail application and stated that the petitioners are not innocent and they have committed the offence U/s 329, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 76, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. Therefore, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioners / accused persons should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the F.I.R it is clear that the case has been

instituted U/s 329, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 76, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. From perusal of case record, it appears that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and 109(1) BNS. is super imposition. This is a case of love affair of informant's grand daughter Rinki Kumari with petitioner Rambali Baitha.

Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case this Court is inclined to admit the petitioners to anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the trial court within four weeks from the date of this order the accused persons / petitioners namely, **1. Ramkishor Baitha, 2. Amlesh Baitha and 3.Dharmendra Baitha @ Jitendra Baitha**, is directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties with condition that they will comply the conditions mentioned under section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
