ORDER

The anticipatory bail petition dated 18.03.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. **Rajan Ram @ Rajan Kumar**, 2. **Mantosh Ram @ Mantosh Kumar**, 3. **Shivji Ram**, 4. **Shivshankar Ram**, 5. **Jogendra Ram @ Yogendra Ram**, 6. **Bhagya Narayan Ram**, 7. **Sosindra Ram**, 8. **Shailandra Ram**, 9. **Chotan Ram @ Ramnandan Ram**, 10. **Ramikbal Ram @ Ramekbal Ram**, 11. **Dablu Kumar** and 12. **Suraj Kumar @ Rajan Kumar**, in connection with Piprahi P.S. Case No. 62/2026 registered for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 76, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 324(4), 117(2), 191(1) of B.N.S. the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution story in brief is that on 04.03.2026 at 05:00 PM, when informant Pratima Devi was going to her maize field to where she found Ram Kumar, Chitranjan Kumar, Rajan Ram, Mantosh Ram all accused persons who suddenly caught hold of her, dragged her inside the field misbehaved with her and threatened her. Then she raise alarm and her relatives arrived there and seeing the relatives the accused persons fled away. Shortly thereafter a larger group armed with sticks entered her house and assaulted her and her family members and they snatched her "*mangalsutra*", and took Rs.12,000 and they also threatened to implicate them in false cases. It is further alleged that during their departure, the accused damaged standing crops causing an estimated loss of Rs.30,000-40,000. Accordingly, the F.I.R. has been instituted

The Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence

whatsoever as alleged. The prosecution case as alleged is false, frivolous, baseless and concocted. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The petitioners are respectable persons of the locality and sound sureties are ready to stand their bailors. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioners should be allowed anticipatory bail.

The Ld. Special P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail application and stated that the petitioners are not innocent and they have committed the offence U/s 126(2), 115(2), 76, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 324(4), 117(2), 191(1) of B.N.S. Therefore, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioners / accused persons should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the F.I.R it is clear that the case has been instituted U/s 126(2), 115(2), 76, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 324(4), 117(2), 191(1) of B.N.S. From perusal of case record, it appears that the Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. After lapse of long time no injury report has been submitted by Ld. P.P. There is land dispute between the informant and the petitioners / accused persons. Case and counter case between the parties and the allegation is not specific.

Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case this Court is inclined to admit the petitioners to anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the trial court within four weeks from the date of this order the accused persons / petitioners namely, **1. Rajan Ram @ Rajan Kumar, 2. Mantosh Ram @ Mantosh Kumar, 3. Shivji Ram, 4. Shivshankar Ram, 5. Jogendra Ram @ Yogendra Ram, 6.**

Bhagya Narayan Ram, 7. Sosindra Ram, 8. Shailandra Ram, 9. Chotan Ram @ Ramnandan Ram, 10. Ramikbal Ram @ Ramekbal Ram, 11. Dablu Kumar and 12. Suraj Kumar @ Rajan Kumar, are directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties with condition that they will comply the conditions mentioned under section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
