<u>Continued</u> <u>20.06.2026</u>	complaint alleging there in, that on 20.08.2025 at about 10:30 P.M, Eqbal Singh, Meghnath Singh, Munna Singh, Jaynath Singh, Vikku Singh, Jay Singh, all entered in her house. Meghnath Singh caught hold of her hair and threw on the ground, Munna Singh molested her and cut her cheek. Vikku Singh and Ekbal Singh were instigating others and on their instigation all the accused persons assaulted and molested for considerable period of time. They have assaulted so severely that she became unconscious and they also removed gold tops of ear and nose and looted Rs 6000 from his house. Accordingly FIR was instituted. Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioners have submitted in para-2 of their anticipatory bail petition that no other anticipatory bail application has been filed or pending before this Court as well as before Hon'ble High Court Patna. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of their anticipatory bail petition. All the allegations leveled against the petitioners are false and fabricated. The real fact is that the petitioner no.2 Eqbal Singh lodged Sheohar P.S. case no. 302/25 against the informant and his son for kidnapping of his son and to save her from that case, she has falsely implicated the above named petitioners in this case. The learned counsel submitted that injury report of informant is of dated 21/08/25 she was examined on 21/08/25 at 1:02 p.m. on which no time of assault has been mentioned on it. Moreover on the injury report age of injury has been mentioned as within 06 hours which itself falsify the alleged facts of the informant as she alleged that occurrence is of 20/08/25. The Learned counsel further submitted that the alleged offence is said to be of 20.08.2025 and written petition for lodging FIR has been filed on 03.09.2025 without any reason of delay which also shows after thought process. Chargesheet has been submitted and petitioners are enjoying benefit u/s 35(3) of BNSS, they are law abiding citizens and they are ready to furnish bail bond as per order of the court. At last it has been prayed to allow the pre-arrest bail of the petitioners. <i>Per contra</i> Ld. APP opposed the prayer of the petitioners for

On perusal of the case record it appears that FIR has been lodged u/s u/s-126(2), 127(2), 115(2),118(1), 76, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. The I.O has been submitted charge-sheet u/s 126(2), 115(2), 127(2), 118(1), 76, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS in which alleged section 118(1), 76 of BNS is non-bailable in nature. Accordingly cognizance has also been taken as per chargesheet by the Court of Learned CJM, Sheohar. On perusal of para -05, of the case diary it appears that allegations of molestation and assault against petitioners are general in nature. From further perusal of para 06 and 07 of the case diary it appears son of Ram Ekbal Singh was missing for which case was registered against informant and her son, regarding which all the accused have enquired from informant and during course of conversation between them alleged incident of quarrelling and misbehaving of informant took place. On perusal of para 12 of the case diary it appears that nature of injury opined by doctor is simple in nature caused by teeth bite and hard and blunt substance, but there is no such allegations of using any arms by the informant. On further perusal of the record, it appears that informant herself has alleged that occurrence took place on 20/08/25 at 10.30 p.m. and Medicolegal Certificate(Injury Report) which was prepared on 21/08/25 on which time of examination is mentioned as 1:02 P.M., date of assault is also mentioned as 21/08/25 but no time of assault is mentioned on it, however age of injury has been mentioned as within 06 hours, which are clearly contradictory with the alleged facts in the written application of the informant. All the petitioners are enjoying benefit u/s 35(3) of BNSS who have been released on bond by IO as mentioned in para 13 of the case diary. Investigation has been completed and Charge-sheet has also been submitted . There is no chances of tampering with the evidences. No criminal antecedent has been mentioned of the petitioners in the entire case diary, the learned counsel has submitted in para-3 of the anticipatory bail petition that petitioners have clean antecedent which is also supported with an affidavit. Moreover, the alleged

<u>Continued</u> <u>20/06/2026</u>	offence is of 20.08.2025 and the petition for lodging an FIR has been filed on 03.09.2025 without any reasonable explanation. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners having clean antecedent, chargesheet has been submitted, this court is inclined to enlarge the above named petitioners to anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned trial court concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners (1) Meghnath Singh, S/o Eqbal Singh @ Ram Eqbal Singh, (2) Eqbal Singh @ Ram Eqbal Singh, S/o Late Hitlal Singh, (3) Jaynath Singh @ Jaynath Kumar Singh, S/o Shail Singh, (4) Jay Singh @ Ajay Kumar Singh S/o Harishchandra Singh, (5) Munna Singh S/o Eqbal Singh @ Ram Eqbal Singh, (6) Vikku Singh S/o Awadh Singh are directed to be released on anticipatory bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court concerned, subject to the further condition that:- (i) One of the bailor shall be either father, mother, brother, sister or any close relative. (ii) the petitioners shall remain physically present in court till framing of charge and shall co-operate during trial. (iii) bailors shall furnished separate declaration/undertaking u/s 486 of BNSS.
