ORDER

20.06.2026 :- That a bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Abhishek Kumar under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S. against the order of rejection of bail by the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar vide order dated 22.04.2026. That the accused person is in judicial custody in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 468/2025 under Section 137(2) and 96 of the B.N.S. That a copy of bail petition has already been served upon the Learned Special Public Prosecution appearing on behalf of the state. That the case was called on. That on call, the Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of both the parties has appeared before this Court.

That the Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of accused petitioner has prayed for the withdrawal of this Bail Petition. That the Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the accused petitioner has prayed to dismiss the instant Bail Petition as withdrawn.

That the Learned Special P.P. has submitted that if the Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the accused petitioner wants to withdraw the bail petition and therefore the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Heard both the parties and perused the case record. That the Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of accused petitioner has

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prayed to withdraw the Bail Petition No. 70/2026 and therefore under such circumstances, it would be proper to dismiss the Bail Petition No. 70/2026 as withdrawn. That since the Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the accused petitioner has prayed to withdraw the Bail Petition and therefore it appears that he does want to proceed for hearing the Bail Petition on merit. That since the Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the accused petitioner has prayed to withdraw the Bail Petition No. 70/2026 and therefore it would be proper to dismiss the Bail Petition No. 70/2026 without hearing on merit on the ground of withdrawal prayed by the Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the accused petitioner. Thus, the bail petition as dismissed as withdrawn.
