APP for the state and perused the case record.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per FIR in brief is dated on 19-04-2026 informant Surti Devi w/o Naresh Sahni along with her grand daughter, grand son and daughter-in-law had gone for harvesting wheat, where Sogarath Sahni, Pintu Sahni, Anil Sahni, Shivji Sahni, Sukhari Sahni, Rekha Devi, Jharokha Devi, Kanti Devi, Dipan Sahni, have assaulted their grand son and grand daughter. Informant further alleged that again at 7:00 p.m. in planned manner carrying <i>lathi danda</i> in their hand came all the petitioners came and started using filthy languages. On her objection they committed <i>maar-peat</i> with her and with the intention to outrage her modesty Pintu Sahni misbehaved with her and snatched her <i>mangalrsutra</i> and golden earring. They also entered in her house and assaulted her daughter-in law and Sogarath Sahni took Rs 10000 from her box. On hearing noise when the neighbours came then all flew away. Accordingly FIR was instituted.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioners have submitted in para-2 of the bail petition that no other anticipatory bail application has been filed or pending before this Court as well as before Hon'ble High Court Patna. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para -03 of their anticipatory bail petition. The learned counsel further submitted that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. The learned counsel further submitted that petitioner no.-04 (Pintu Sahani) had gone to catch fish in the river where informant's <i>devar</i> Baljeet Sahni along with others assaulted him for which Sheohar PS case no. 158/26 was lodged and to put pressure, this false case has been instituted against petitioners after two</p> |  |

There is no chances of absconding of petitioners and they are ready to furnish bail bond as per order of the court. At last it has been prayed to allow the pre-arrest bail of the petitioners.</p> <p><i>Per contra</i> Ld. APP opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Heard both sides and perused the case record.</p> <p>On perusal of the case record it appears that FIR has been lodged u/s 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2) of BNS in which section 74 and 303(2) are non-bailable. Allegations against the petitioners are of causing assault, outraging modesty of informant and committing theft. From perusal of para 02, 07, 08 and 16 of the case diary it appears that there is no specific allegations of outraging of modesty against the petitioners named above and the allegations of theft appears be ornamental and omnibus. All the other alleged sections are bailable in nature. There is no criminal history as mentioned in para 29 of the case diary which has also been mentioned in para no. 3 of the anticipatory bail petition that petitioners are having clean antecedent which is supported with an affidavit.</p> <p>Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, petitioners having clean antecedent, this court is inclined to enlarge the above named petitioners to anticipatory bail. It is therefore ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned trial court concerned within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order the petitioners <b>(1)Jharokha Devi, (2) Kanti Devi, (3) Dipan Sahni, (4) Pintu Sahni, (5) Shivji Sahni, (6) Anil Sahni, (7) Sukhari Sahni, (8) Sogarath Sahni, (9) Rekha Devi,</b> are directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of</p> |  |
