Mangal Rai Vs. State of Bihar

ORDER

22.06.2026

The bail petition dated 04.06.2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Mangal Rai**, who is in judicial custody since 27.05.2026, in connection with Tariyani, P.S. Case No. 104/2026 registered for the offence u/s 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S. and the same has been put today for the order.

The prosecution case in brief is that on 07.05.2025 at about 5:00 PM the accused person, namely Ramakant Rai, Mangal Rai, Ramdev Rai, Jainaryan Rai, Arjun Rai, Kunti Devi, Rinku Devi, Asha Devi, Radha Devi and Rajesh Rai's wife, all residents of Village Pahadpur, P.S. Tariyani, District Sheohar intentionally strangulated deceased Ranvir Kumar to death and in order to conceal the offence they allegedly hanged the dead body at the staircase of informant's house. The prosecution further alleges that the accused persons had previously threatened the deceased with dire consequences. Accordingly, the F.I.R. has been instituted.

The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence whatsoever as alleged. It is further submitted that the prosecution case as alleged is false, frivolous, baseless and concocted. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is respectable person of the locality and sound sureties are ready to stand his bailors. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioner should be allowed bail.

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The Ld. Additional P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail application and stated that the he has committed the offences U/s 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S. Therefore, the bail application of the petitioner / accused person should be rejected.

Heard both the parties and perused the record.

After perusal of the F.I.R it is clear that the case has been instituted U/s 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S. From perusal of L.C.R, it appears that the investigation has been completed in this case and final form has been submitted and there is no allegation of tempering with the evidence against the accused persons. Though the FIR is against ten accused persons but the eyewitness Pooja Kumari stated that she had seen only three accused persons namely Ramakant Rai, Kunti Devi and Mangal Rai at the place of occurrence. The statement of so called eyewitness Pooja Kumari totally differ from the statement of informant. The informant and other witnesses have said that the deceased has died due to strangulated but the medical report or PM report says that the cause of death is hanging. From perusal of the case record it also appears that a rape case Tariyani P.S. Case No. 103/2025 has been filed by the accused Ramakant Rai against the deceased Ranvir Kumar. Other accused persons are relatives. Hence false implication cannot be overruled. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in judicial custody since 27.05.2026 and the petitioner is ready to co-operate in the trial of the case.

Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case

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the accused / petitioner **Mangal Rai** is ordered to be released on bail after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousands) with two sureties with condition that he will be present physically before the court on each and every date till framing of charge and he will co-operate in the trial of the case.
