Sanjay Tyagi vs State (NCT of Delhi)

26.05.2026

Fresh revision petition received by way of assignment. It be checked and registered.

Present : Sh. Avinash Kumar Tyagi, Ld. Counsel for the revisionist/petitioner.

1. As per report of Ahlmad, file has also been received on e-portal.

2. Heard. Perused.

3. By impugned judgment dated 28.04.2026, the appellant- Sanjay Tyagi was convicted for the offences punishable u/s 147/452/323/325 IPC r/w Section 34 IPC. By order on sentence dated 28.04.2026, the appellant- Sanjay Tyagi was sentenced as under:-

i. Appellant was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one year and to pay fine of Rs. 10,000/- for the offence punishable u/s 147 IPC. In default of payment of fine, appellant was directed additional simple imprisonment for a period of three months,

ii. Appellant was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two years and to pay fine of Rs. 10,000/- for the offence punishable u/s 452 IPC. In default of payment of fine, appellant was directed additional simple imprisonment for a period of six months,

iii. Appellant was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of six months and to pay fine of Rs. 10,000/- for the offence punishable u/s 323 IPC. In default of payment of fine, appellant was directed additional simple imprisonment for a period of one month, and

iv. Appellant was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two years and to pay fine of Rs. 10,000/- for the offence punishable u/s 325 IPC. In default of payment of fine, appellant was directed additional simple imprisonment for a period of six months.

3. The appellant has also moved an application u/s 389 Cr.P.C/430 BNSS seeking stay/suspension of sentence and for grant of bail to the appellant, during the pendency of the appeal.

4. The appellant has raised some arguable points in the appeal and disposal of this appeal may take time, therefore, the operation of impugned order shall remain suspended during the pendency of this appeal.

5. The appellant is admitted to bail for the period of pendency of this appeal, on furnishing of personal bond in the sum

of Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court within 10 days from today.

6. Issue notice of the appeal to the respondent on filing PF/RC for the next date.
7. Re-notify on **17.07.2026**.
8. Copy of order be given dasti.
