ORDER

13.09.2019. Bail petition filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Narayan Ram, who is in custody since 01.09.2019 in connection with Korma p.s.case no.62/2019, excise case no.290/2019 registered for the offence u/s 30 (a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, pending in this court moved today.

Heard the learned lawyer for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the state.

The prosecution case in brief is that on 01.09.2019 the informant received secret information that in village Murarpur tati pul some persons were carrying away liquor. On such information the informant along with police force reached there and recovered 10 liters of country made liquor each from then possession of the accused petitioner when they were carrying away to supply the same, accordingly seizure list was prepared.

The learned lawyer for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence. It has been submitted that the petitioners do labour work. It has been submitted that there is nothing recovered from the conscious possession of the accused petitioner. It has been submitted that the petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding, accordingly, prayer for bail has been made.

The learned A.P.P. for the state vehemently opposed the prayer of bail and submitted that the petitioner is named accused in this case and 10 liters country made liquor

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each has been recovered from the accused petitioner, accordingly prayer has been made to reject the bail petition filed on behalf of the accused petitioner named above.

Heard both the sides and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record it appears that the informant received secret information that in village Murarpur tati pul some persons were carrying away liquor. There is allegation of recovery of 10 liters of country made liquor contained in plastic gallon when he was carrying away the same. The criminal antecedent of he accused petitioner Narayan Ram was called for and the same has been received that no criminal antecedent of the accused. The accused petitioner is in custody since 01.09.2019. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case the accused petitioner is ordered to be released on bail after furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each.
